The Montessori Program is for students in kindergarten through fifth grade. Each classroom serves a variety of ages and academic levels.

We accept students on a space-available, annual basis.

To apply for our Montessori program fill out the following forms:

- Parent/Guardian Questionnaire
- An “**Out-of-District**” Form” is required annually for students who do not reside in the Central Kitsap School District boundary.
- For students that reside in the Bremerton School District, will need to fill out both the Bremerton Form and fill out the School Choice Application on-line at www.ckschools.org.
- For students that reside in the North Kitsap School District, will need to fill out both the North Kitsap Form and fill out the School Choice Application on-line at www.ckschools.org.

Students must remain “**in good standing**”. This means maintaining acceptable attendance and punctuality; which means no more than 6 tardies or excessive absences per trimester, academic progress; and no serious discipline issues.

Parents will have an opportunity (optional) to provide information about academic, social, behavior and other student needs which will be considered by the school team when placing students. These Class placement forms will be available for parent pickup May 13th – May 24th. We value your input but placement with individual teachers will be made by the school.
